Dear Canary Club Friends,

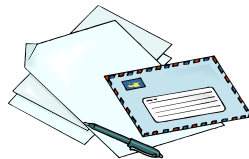

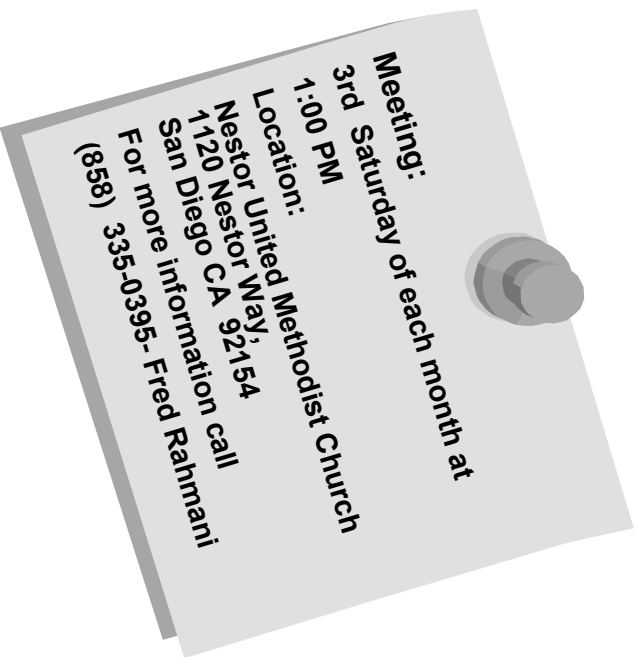
